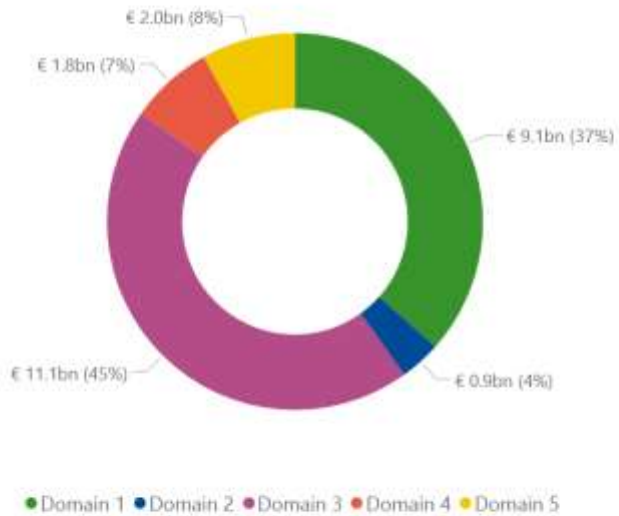

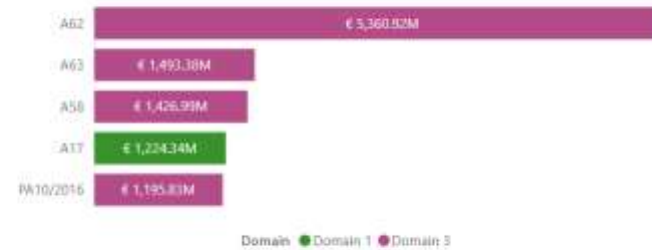
Overview of JVAP Data with the 2022 Data Collection Cycle



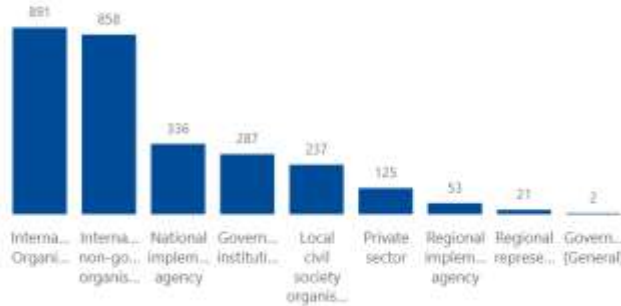

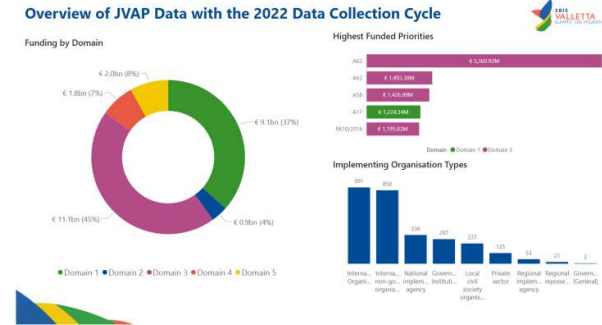

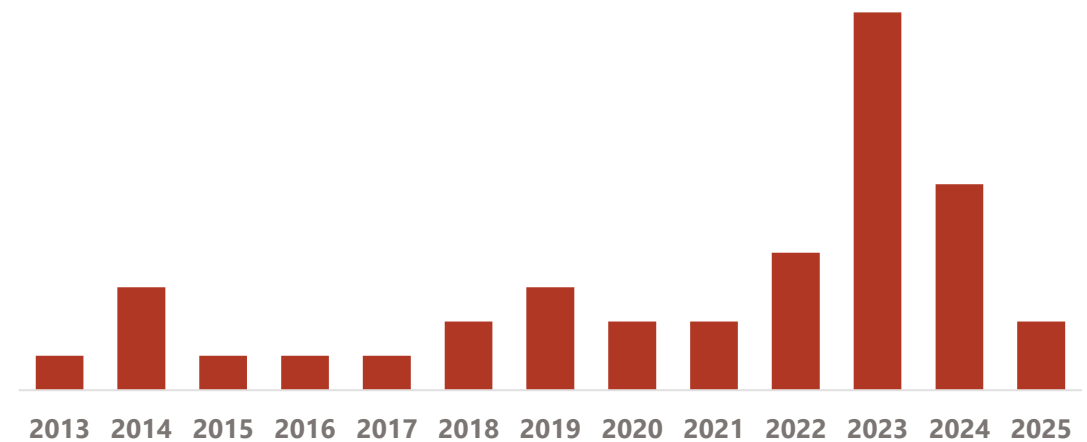

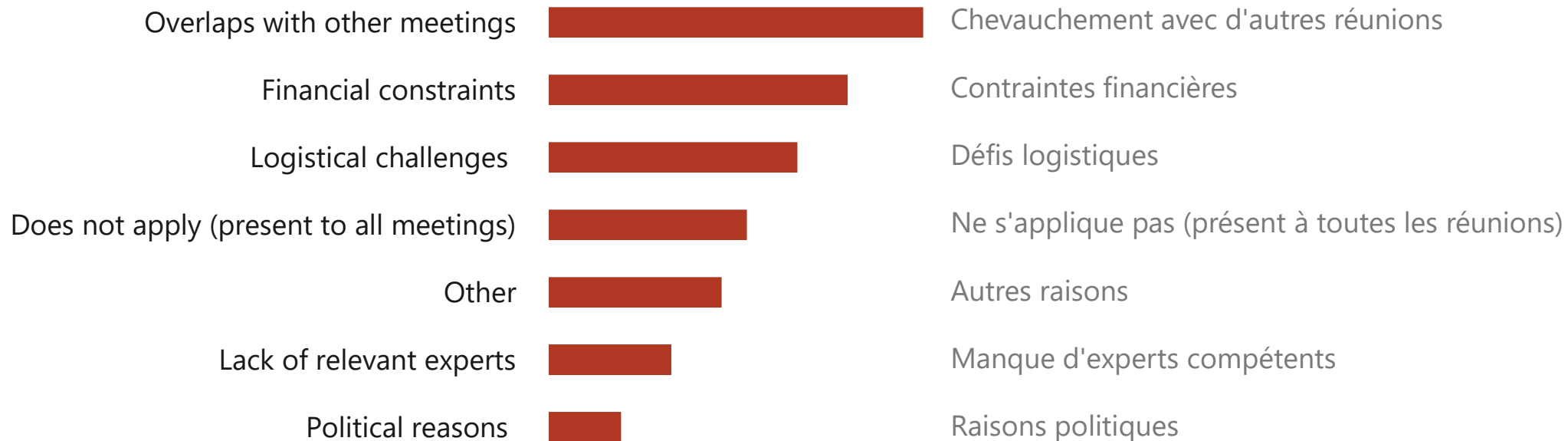

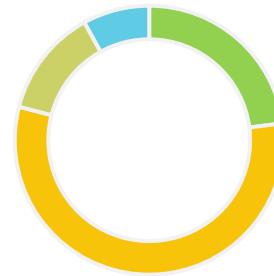

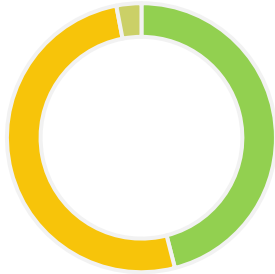

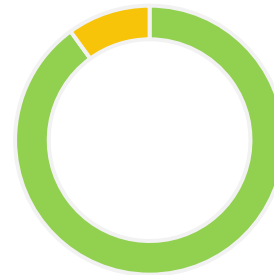

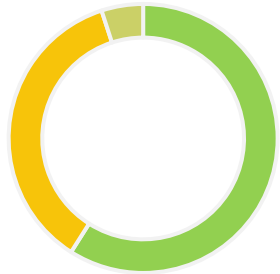

Objective of Nigeria's Chairmanship

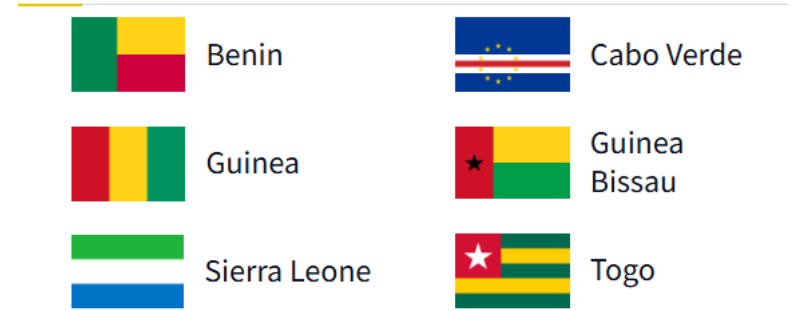
Nigeria's chairmanship will aim to foster stronger partnerships, enhance policy coherence, and deliver meaningful outcomes across the Rabat Process region.

- Drive forward meaningful dialogue and actions, working alongside both African and European partners to address the complexities of migration along critical routes.
- Work to ensure that migration is well-managed and contributes positively to the development and well-being of individuals and communities across borders

Championing Regional Cooperation

Nigeria faces unique migration challenges, which present opportunities to strengthen regional cooperation, particularly within the Economic Community of West African States (ECOWAS).

As a founding member and one of the largest economies in the region, Nigeria has a longstanding tradition of championing regional integration and fostering unity among West African nations. Over the years, Nigeria has consistently demonstrated its commitment to regional stability, economic growth, and development by spearheading initiatives aimed at addressing common challenges such as security, trade, migration, and infrastructure development. Nigeria will leverage its chairmanship to champion regional cooperation and promote capacity development initiatives that facilitate knowledge-sharing and the exchange of good practices among partner countries.



Championing Regional Cooperation

Additionally, Nigeria seeks to align its national migration priorities with global frameworks, including the Cadiz Action Plan, the Global Compact for Migration (GCM), and the Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs). Specifically, we aim to advance SDG 10 which calls for the facilitation of “orderly, safe, regular, and responsible migration and mobility”.

- Under our leadership, we are committed to addressing the multifaceted challenges of migration by prioritizing practical and impactful solutions. We will leverage this platform to advocate for approaches to migration that are inclusive, equitable, and sustainable, ensuring that our strategies align with global best practices while meeting the unique needs of all stakeholders involved.
- Through this focused and results-driven leadership, we aim to foster meaningful collaboration, promote innovative policies, and enhance the overall effectiveness of migration governance.



A Balanced and Humane Approach

By fostering synergies between national, regional, and global frameworks, Nigeria aims to strengthen the Rabat Process's role in creating a balanced and humane approach to migration governance. This approach will benefit migrants, countries of origin, transit, and destination alike.



Core Priorities for the Nigerian Chairmanship

Youth and Innovation

- The potential of youth to address emerging challenges and opportunities related to migration is increasingly recognised. In light of youth unemployment in Nigeria and the impact of the *japa syndrome*, there is a growing emphasis on this topic.

Pathways to Regularization

- Empowering migrants by building inclusive pathways. The Chairmanship will advocate for the development and expansion of regular migration pathways to enhance mobility opportunities.

Improving Migration Data Management

- Data plays a critical role in migration governance. There is a strong commitment to ensuring that policies are inclusive, evidence-based, and value-driven. The Chairmanship will work to advance migration data management by promoting best practices in data collection and analysis, enabling more informed and effective policy decisions.

Promote Respect of the Dignity and Human Rights

- Nigeria is committed to advancing the issue of **missing migrants**. This includes a proposed meeting in Banjul, co-chaired by The Gambia and Switzerland, where members of the Network of National Focal Points for Missing Migrants, along with regional and international organisations, would be invited to participate and contribute to the discussions.





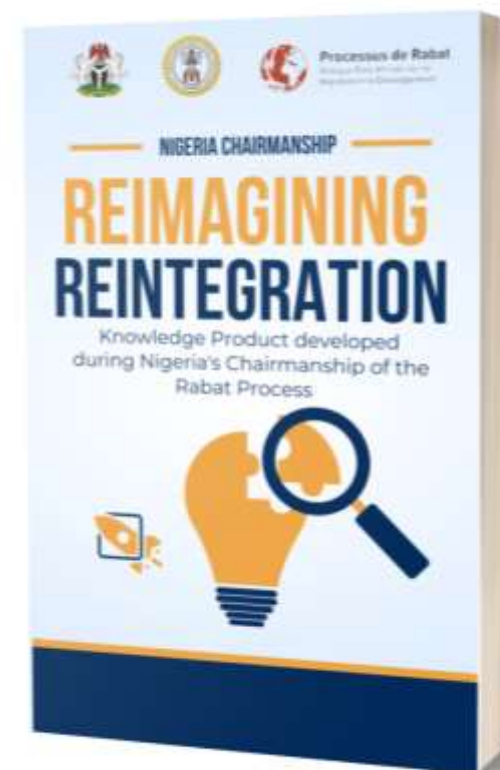
Additional Thematic Interests

- Given the pressing challenges of climate-induced displacement, such as the recent catastrophic flooding in Nigeria that displaced over 2 million people, Nigeria is committed to supporting a joint meeting of both Dialogues to address climate-related migration.

- Addressing human trafficking requires a comprehensive, all-of-community approach, encompassing legislation, law enforcement, international collaboration, and victim support services.



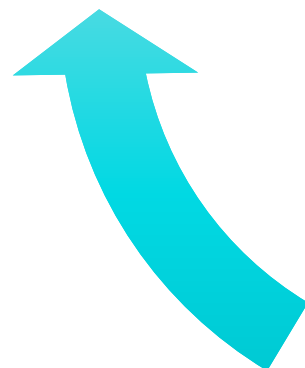
